On National Future Day, school children in grades 5 to 7 are given the opportunity to spend a day gaining insights into the world of work. Typically, children accompany their parents or close family friends to their workplaces to experience everyday professional life. Unfortunately, this opportunity is often not available to children from socially disadvantaged backgrounds.

To address this issue, Life Science Cares
Switzerland is seeking corporate partners within
the life sciences industry, who are willing to offer placements
on Future Day specifically for children from underprivileged families.
This initiative aims to provide these young school children with meaningful exposure to the diverse and dynamic life sciences sector.

Who are we adressing?

Our program is aimed at students in grades 5 to 7 who come from socially disadvantaged families.

What are our objectives?

With our program we pursue three key objectives:

- Provide children from underprivileged families with exposure to the life sciences industry
- Promote social integration across different socio-economic backgrounds
- Identify and inspire potential future talents for the life science sector
